

## OG Shorty's Snowboard Backpack.

Holds snowboard and boots on the outside, with a large roomy interior. Also easily holds a skateboard. Three inch wide dense padded waist strap takes the weight off your shoul-ders. The zipper flaps on the main compartment and the hidden pocket face towards the back for easy access with a snowboard still attached. Protective zipper flaps on main zipper and front pocket. Strong boot straps on sides, and 2" board straps. Two inch webbing strap protects the backpack from the sharp edges of the snowboard.

Extra large front zippered pouch. Back and bottom have dense padding for protection and support. Padded shoulder straps. Boot straps, shoulder straps, and waist straps are all adjustable. Drag Handle. Height, 23". Width, 13". Depen, 11"



OG Shorty's Skateboard Duffel. Two tone duffel has strong 2" straps that attach with velcro to hold a skateboard. Extra removable gear strap for heavy loads. Large outside zippered pocket. Two sturdy straps attach in the middle with a comfortable closable handle. Height, 14". Width, 28". Depth, 14"
